As of 2000, Marshfield had a population of 1,496, comprised completely of rural residents. The population has increased by 12.4% since 1990. Marshfield contains an even amount of males and females. Approximately 50% of the total population is male, while 50% is female. Table A. shows the breakdown of age groups amongst the total population in Marshfield. Approximately 29% of the population is children, age 18 and under, while 9% of the population is senior citizens, age 65 and over. The number of residents age 18 and under and age 65 and over has increased throughout the last decade. There are currently 10.3% more children and 16.8% more senior citizens in Marshfield than there were in 1990.

Of the total population in Marshfield, 100% live in households. Of these people, 86% live in family households, while 14% live in nonfamily households. Of the 572 total households in Marshfield, 72% are family households, while 28% are nonfamily households. Most of the family households contain 2 to 4 persons. Approximately 43% are 2-person households, while 23% are 3-person households, and 23% are 4-person households. Most of the nonfamily households contain 1 or 2 persons. Approximately 75% are 1-person households and 21% are 2-person households. Compared to 1990, there are currently 19.2% more households in Marshfield. See Table B. for details related to household data.

Of the 410 total families that reside in Marshfield, approximately 77% are married-couple families. Of these married-couple families, 49% have children under the age of 18, while 51% do not have children under the age of 18. The remaining 23% of families in Marshfield fall under the category of other family. See Table C. for details. Approximately 52% of these families have a female householder with no husband present, while 48% have a male householder with no wife present. In total, there are 51.2% more families residing in Marshfield than there were in 1990.

In Marshfield, there are 772 workers age 16 and over, which is a 23.5% increase from 1990. Approximately 25% of these workers work in Marshfield, while 75% work outside of the community. The majority of workers, 84%, travel to work by car, truck, van, or motorcycle. Approximately 88% of those who travel to work by car, truck, van, or motorcycle drive alone, while 12% use carpools. See Table D. for other means of transportation used by workers in Marshfield. Although there are a range of travel times for Marshfield workers, 22% commute between 5 and 19 minutes. Approximately 48% commute between 20 and 39 minutes. Only 2.5% travel less than 5 minutes to work, while 1.3% travel more than 90 minutes to work from Marshfield.

In Marshfield, there were 379 people attending school at some level in 2000, which is a 6.5% increase from 1990. A range of educational attainment is represented by the population in Marshfield. Only 0.5% of all residents 25 years and older have not completed any level of schooling, while 37.5% have only a high school diploma. Approximately 38% of Marshfield residents 25 years and older hold some type of degree, ranging from an Associates degree to a Doctorate degree. See Table E. for details.

In Marshfield, there are 819 residents in the labor force, which is 73.3% of the population age 16 and over. This is a 16.5% increase from 1990. Approximately 96% of the people in the civilian labor force are employed, while 4% are unemployed. The 34 residents that are unemployed represent 44.3% less than the unemployment level in 1990. All of the industries covered in the Census are represented by residents of Marshfield. The industries with the largest percentage of workers are: education, health, and social services, which represents 25.7% of employed residents; retail trade, which represents 11.7% of employed residents; manufacturing, which represents 11.1% of employed

residents; and public administration, which represents 9.7% of employed residents. See Table F. for details.

Table G. shows household income and family income data for Marshfield. All income classes are represented here. Approximately 8% of the total households have an income of less than \$10,000; 18.5% have an income between \$10,000 and \$25,000; 36.5% have an income between \$25,000 and \$50,000; 21% have an income between \$50,000 and \$75,000; 10% have an income between \$75,000 and \$100,000; and 6% have an income above \$100,000. In 1999, the median household income in Marshfield was \$40,603, which is a 47.1% increase from 1990. Approximately 6% of the total families have an income of less than \$10,000; 13.5% have an income between \$10,000 and \$25,000; 40% have an income between \$25,000 and \$50,000; 25% have an income between \$50,000 and \$75,000; 9% have an income between \$75,000 and \$100,000; and 6.5% have an income above \$100,000. In 1999, the median family income in Marshfield was \$44,063, which is a 51.4% increase from 1990. In 1999, the per capita income for Marshfield was \$18,649, a 69.8% increase from 1990. Approximately 9% of people in Marshfield for whom poverty status is determined have incomes below poverty level. Fortunately, the 135 residents who have incomes below poverty level are 12.3 % less than those who suffered from poverty in 1990.

There are 686 total housing units in Marshfield, all of which are located in a rural area. This is a 27% increase from the total housing units in 1990. Approximately 84% of these

housing units are currently occupied, leaving 16% vacant. Of these vacant housing units, 12.6% are for rent, while 8% are for sale. Approximately 54% of the vacant housing units are for seasonal, recreational, or occasional use. There are currently 85% more housing vacancies in Marshfield than there were in 1990 and the occupancy level has increased by 19.8% over the last decade. See Table H. for details.

Of the 575 total occupied housing units in Marshfield, 58% are 1 to 2 person households, while 34% are 3 to 4 person households. Of the 686 total housing units in the Town, most have between 4 and 8 rooms. Approximately 11% have 1 to 2 rooms; 18% have 3 to 4 rooms; 39% have 5 to 6 rooms; 22% have 7 to 8 rooms; and 10% have 9 or more rooms. Many of the housing units in Marshfield were built prior to 1980. Approximately 36.5% of the houses were built before 1939; 32.5% were built between 1940 and 1979; and 31% were built after 1980. Approximately 90% of the total housing units in Marshfield contain complete plumbing facilities, leaving 10% without adequate plumbing. See Table J. for details.
